Boat Overview

Model: 22' Lexington Pontoon

Engine: 150 HP outboard

Capacity: 10–12 passengers

Fuel: Regular unleaded

Top Speed: ~25–30 mph

Features: Bimini top, Bluetooth stereo, cooler, navigation lights, 2 batteries

Safety Equipment

12 Life Jackets (8 adult, 2 youth, 2 toddler)

2 Throw Cushions

Fire Extinguisher-located in battery compartment

First Aid Kit- in safety container under dash

Whistle

Important Rules

Important Rules

No anchor — remain in safe open water

Do not beach or bank the boat

No smoking on the boat

Before You Depart

Safety check, weather review, passenger briefing, balanced load

Starting the Engine

1. Key ON
2. Attach kill switch
3. Neutral throttle
4. Start
5. Warm up

Operating

- Smooth throttle and steering
Forward = go, back = reverse
- Turn early, go slow near docks
- Obey NO WAKE zones

Docking

Slow approach, early turns, secure front and back lines (ropes and fenders provided)

Fueling

Engine off, no smoking, regular unleaded, must be returned FULL

Returning by 7PM SHARP

Remove trash, report issues, leave clean
